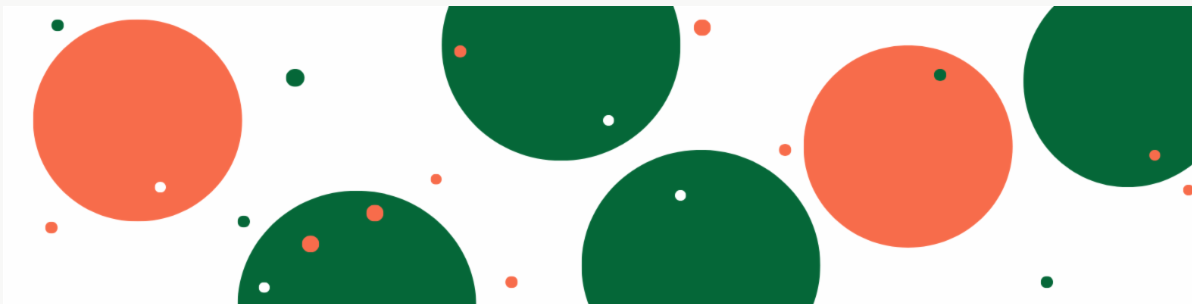

How C@N you help?

The position of Call Center Volunteer has been created to support our ministerial work and mission. Our Call Center answers calls placed to our Assistance Helpline, the first point of contact of a neighbor in need (client) with our organization. Volunteers in this vital role are the connection between the needs of our community and the help that our Conferences and Vincentians provide through our programs.

Key Responsibilities:

- Answer inbound calls from the Assistance Helpline
- Listen to the client and ask appropriate questions to determine what their needs are
- Document the request, per standard operating procedure, in Salesforce (case management system)

Age Requirements: 18+, background check and orientation required, costs covered by SVDP.

How C@N you help?

The position of Retail Production Assistant supports the Erlanger Thrift Store. All merchandise in the St. Vincent de Paul Northern Kentucky thrift stores are donated items from our Northern Kentucky community. Revenue from the sale of donated items benefits the programs and services we offer, assisting over 58,000 neighbors annually with basic emergency needs and thereby providing hope for a brighter future situation. By completing key responsibilities, volunteers help to get merchandise prepared and out on to the sales floor, increasing inventory, resulting in increased revenue for programs and services.

Key Responsibilities:

- Do a final check of donated clothing for holes, stains, and anything that would make it unsellable
- Tag and hang sellable donated clothing on Z racks
- Assist with the sorting of donated books and/or toys
- Assist with the testing and sorting of donated electronics
- Assist employees with placement of sellable items on the salesfloor as directed
- Assist with the pairing and binding of shoes

This opportunity is available for individuals or groups!

Age Requirements: 6yr+, anyone under 16 needs to be accompanied by an adult. Please wear closed toed shoes.

We are seeking volunteer tutors for our Homework Plus program, which meets Monday through Thursday from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. during the school year. The 2026–2027 academic year runs from Tuesday, September 8, 2026, through Thursday, May 13, 2027.

Tutors work one-on-one with students to provide homework assistance, reading and writing support, and individualized academic skill-building based on each student's unique needs. No teaching experience is required - just patience, encouragement, and a desire to help children succeed.

Volunteers may serve one or more afternoons per week, depending on their availability.

Age Requirements: Volunteers must be High School age and up (please note that volunteers 18 years or older must be Virtus-trained and compliant).

Volunteer Receptionist

As the first point of contact for visitors and clients, you'll warmly welcome everyone who enters the building. Your role includes greeting visitors, making them feel at home, and answering phone calls for the Catholic Charities staff.

Administrative Support and Pre-Service

Assist with client services by processing payments, making phone calls, and helping clients complete forms, among other tasks. Flexible scheduling is available.

Business Office Support

Proficient in data entry with a basic understanding of accounting principles and a strong willingness to learn.

Assist in preparing meals at Parish Kitchen on weekdays or weekends.

Prayer/Scripture Ministry

Meet in the detention centers with a group of inmates at a prescribed time in the evenings. Lead or assist with Scripture reading, prayers, and discussion with the inmates about our Faith. If you are leading it requires some preparation time such as selecting readings/prayers, printing out materials to read and being prepared to discuss your thoughts on the readings/prayers. Volunteers don't need to attend every week. However, it is imperative that volunteers are open to commit to visit the jail on a specific schedule to ensure that the men and women who want to hear the Word of God can count on someone being present during the scheduled time period.

Family & Friends of Incarcerated Support Group

Support Group for Families of the Incarcerated

Join us for monthly meetings with the relatives and friends of those who are incarcerated. This group offers a supportive space to share feelings and experiences. Occasionally, a representative from the Department of Corrections will attend to provide valuable information for family members. Meetings take place at the Catholic Charities office.

Age Requirement: Age 14 with a parent or adult. Must complete a background check if age 18 or older.
